### Piazza Brescia as Jurassic Park

A bloody battle between ferocious Tyrannosaurs Rex. An exhibition space with perspectives on Segosaurus, Centrosaurus and Ankylosaurus. There's a real Jurassic Park in piazza Brescia! Thanks to the sand sculptures, the event organized by Jesolo tourism department, this year is focused on the theme "Sand Raptors". As it happened in other successful exhibitions on big and fierce prehistoric predators, Jesolo also dedicates its summer sand sculptures to the theme so loved by children. Piazza Brescia has thus transformed into a prehistoric forest, enriched by copies of prehistoric specimens of Jesolo Natural History Museum. The exhibition is open every day until 16 September.

### The charm of the jetties... but no diving allowed!

There are 84 jetties distributed along the Jesolo coastline. They were built to protect the shore from erosion caused by the damaging impact of the sea when rough. However, for tourists they have become part and parcel of the city, a feature worth photographing, a place on which to sunbathe or to share a kiss in the moonlight. But one thing is forbidden: diving into the water. Although they look inviting due to their position, the ban is in place due to the fact that even at the far end of the jetty, the water is very shallow. The risk of getting seriously hurt is real. So remember: enjoy the sea, but no diving from the jetty!

## THINGS TO DO



### Watching Jesolo...from a ferris wheel

The ferris wheel is there again for summer 2018, in the Piazza Brescia area, half way along the sea-front. Enjoy the landscape of the Veneto Riviera, from the lagoon to the hinterland from 60 metres' height and let yourselves be overwhelmed by plays on light and magical atmospheres, in the utmost comfort offered by the special air-conditioned cabins.

Every day from 5 pm. Price: 10 Euro adults; 8 Euro children over 1 mt until 1,40 mt tall; 6 Euro children under 1 mt tall.

### Schie

They are grey shrimps typical of Venice lagoon and the Po Delta, not very meaty and considered poor food as they are cheap and easy to find.

*Schie* area very easy dish to prepare – they just need boiling for about 10 minutes, seasoning with extra virgin olive oil, garlic, salt and parsley and serving with the ubiquitous creamy polenta.

### Leonardo da Vinci, the great Master, in Venice

Discovering the genius of Leonardo da Vinci, in the heart of the most romantic and fascinating city of the world, Venice. It's possible thanks to the Leonardo da Vinci Museum, situated in Campo San Rocco 3052, inside the Scoletta, part of the majestic Scuola Grande di San Rocco monumental complex. The exhibition offers an engaging journey to discover the world of Leonardo da Vinci through interactive machines, multimedia videos, educational laboratories, graphic info, anatomical studies and his main pictorial works. So, visitors will enjoy the feeling of being in the past and immersed in all that Leonardo da Vinci has been capable of thinking and creating. Entrance fee is 8 €, reduced fee is 5 €; disabled and children under 6 years old are free.

Opening hours : from 1st November to 31st March: 1 pm - 5.30 p.m.; from 1st April to 31st October: 10 a.m.- 6.30 p.m.
