Jesolo, world capital of Kickboxing

Jesolo will host the Kickboxing World Championships from 15 to 23 September 2018. The expected flow is about 1500 athletes from over 50 countries of the five continents, reaching about 3 thousand presences in the area including the athletes, technicians, managers and escorts. The Wako Championship (World Association of Kickboxing Organizations) for Cadets and Juniors will take place at the Palazzo del Turismo in Piazza Brescia. The last Wako Championship in Jesolo dates back to 2002. The organization said: "Thanks to our experience and professionalism, we guarantee the maximum commitment for the realization of the event. We are sure that the City of Jesolo and its institutions will benefit from this extraordinary sporting event".

Atvo Jesolo Express - Marco Polo Airport

ATVO offers a comfortable bus service from/to Marco Polo Airport to/from Lido di Jesolo: frequent scheduled trips, plus eight daily express services including already in the price luggage and urban bus from Jesolo bus station to your accommodation and/or viceversa. If you book your tickets online, at the airport you can go directly to the bus departure stop, immediately outside the arrivals hall, show your tickets (optional printing) to ATVO's staff and leave for Jesolo, avoiding driving and parking stress. On the way back the bus will also drop you off directly in front of the passenger terminal. You will travel by comfortable, air-conditioned buses, equipped with a large baggage space beneath the passenger compartment.

THINGS TO DO



The land of River Piave

Cycling along the ancient Litoranea Veneta (a canal linking Venice with Trieste) takes us to Cortellazzo, a quaint little port and fishing village at the mouth of the River Piave, and the reclaimed land of Torre di Fine, Brian and Eraclea. A boat bridge takes us across the river and then we cycle to explore a territory rich in history, culture and traditions and going through rural hamlets, seeing draining pumps, water works, natural oases and crops typically grown on reclaimed land. There is a visit to a farm (Azienda Agricola La Fagiana) which owns one of the area's last paddy fields; we cycle through coastal woods and waterways linked to Italy's history.

A TASTE OF JESOLO



Venetian Style Liver

An ancient recipe of Venetian tradition. The original recipe uses vinegar for practical reasons since there were no fridges in the past and vinegar covered the strong smell that liver developed after a few days.

- 500 g veal liver
- 500 g onion
- 120 g seed oil
- vinegar to taste
- 50 g flour
- salt and pepper

Slice the liver finely and brown it in a fryingpan with a little oil, then add a dash of fine vinegar. Slice the liver finely, coat it in flour and cook on a high heat for a few minutes. Add the onion, season with salt and pepper and if needed add a little water then finish cooking. Serve the dish with hot, white polenta.

The Doge's hidden treasures at the Doge's Palace

Following the important conservative renovation that has re-established the original decorative splendour, the suggestive rooms of the Doge's Chiesetta and Antichiesetta become the heart of an unprecedented and fascinating historical-artistic tour. The guided tour lasts about 1 hour and 15 minutes, with a minimum of 2 participants and a maximum of 10, booking is mandatory. Beginning is set for 11:00 a.m. in Italian, 11:45 a.m. in English and 12:30 a.m. in French. Entrance fee is 20,00 Euro, reduced fee is 14,00 Euro, entrance at the Doge's Palace is included.
