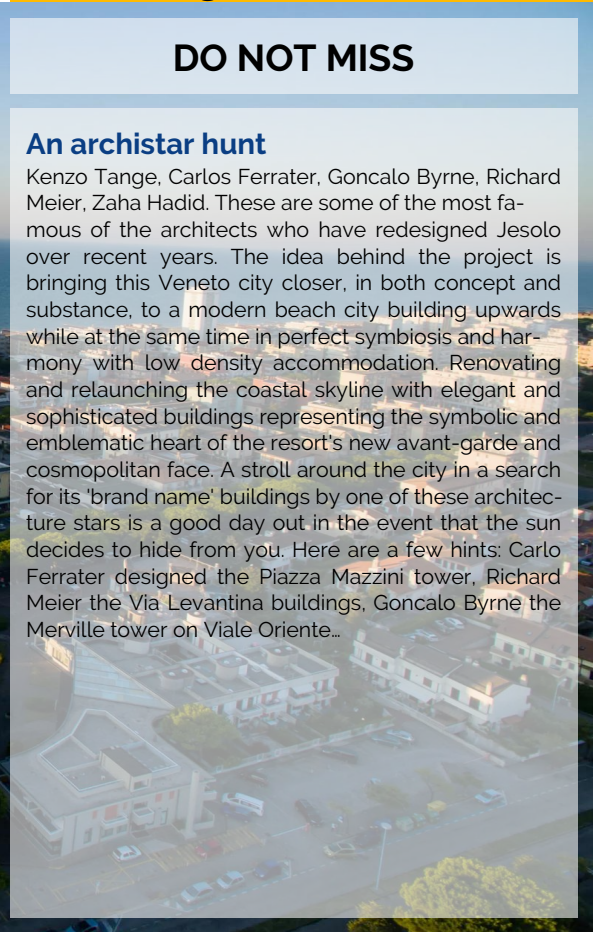

An archistar hunt

Kenzo Tange, Carlos Ferrater, Goncalo Byrne, Richard Meier, Zaha Hadid. These are some of the most famous of the architects who have redesigned Jesolo over recent years. The idea behind the project is bringing this Veneto city closer, in both concept and substance, to a modern beach city building upwards while at the same time in perfect symbiosis and harmony with low density accommodation. Renovating and relaunching the coastal skyline with elegant and sophisticated buildings representing the symbolic and emblematic heart of the resort's new avant-garde and cosmopolitan face. A stroll around the city in a search for its 'brand name' buildings by one of these architecture stars is a good day out in the event that the sun decides to hide from you. Here are a few hints: Carlo Ferrater designed the Piazza Mazzini tower, Richard Meier the Via Levantina buildings, Goncalo Byrne the Merville tower on Viale Oriente...



DID YOU KNOW?

The Winged Lion as symbol of Venice

The symbol of Venice is a winged lion with an open book under the right front paw. The Latin inscription engraved on that Sacred Book reads: "Pax Tibi Marce Evangelista Meus", that is: "Peace to you my Evangelist Mark". When the Lion of San Marco was represented on paintings or sculptures holding a sword, it meant that Venice was a period of war. Most of the lions being in Venice were destroyed by the Napoleonic troops in 1797 at the end of the Serenissima. The ones we see currently on display on the Basilica are all faithful copies of the originals. There are 13 lions visible today in the Marcian area.

Mg - the multimedia museum

Inaugurated in December 2018, the Mg Museum is an ethnographic and contemporary history museum located in Mestre. It is part of a new generation of museums. The multimedia content of the museum, selected by over 40 experts known all over the country, brings a heritage that is often unknown to a wider audience. Through a network of almost 150 Italian and international archives and libraries, Mg celebrates the cultural heritage of the 20th century: photographs, newspapers, magazines, posters, advertising materials, radio recordings, films and documentaries, amateur films and TV shows. The exhibition includes over 6,000 photos, 820 videos, 500 examples of printed materials, 400 audio files, and 10 hours of digital films. Mg is a museum worth exploring and touching with your own hands. It is a unique experience in which visitors and installations interact.
