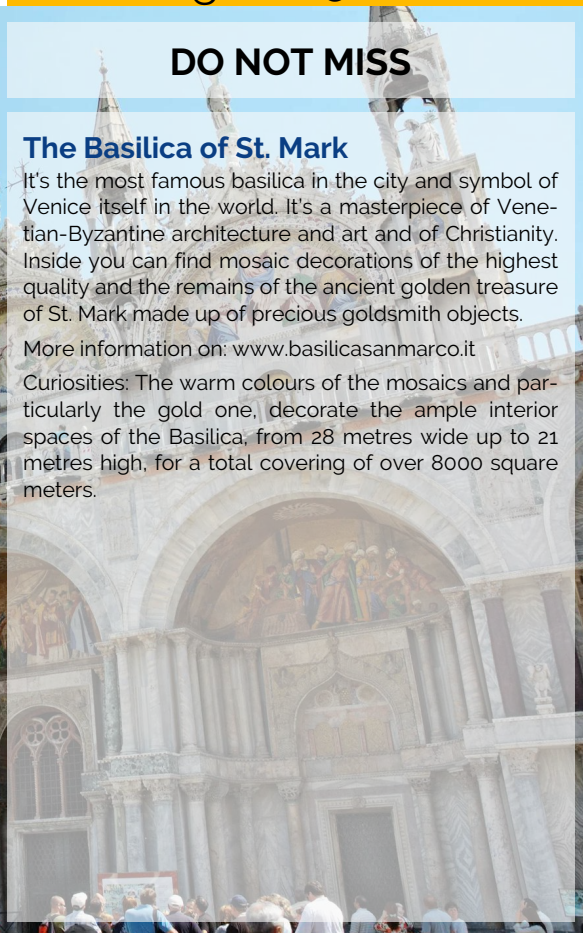
DO NOT MISS

The Basilica of St. Mark

It's the most famous basilica in the city and symbol of Venice itself in the world. It's a masterpiece of Venetian-Byzantine architecture and art and of Christianity. Inside you can find mosaic decorations of the highest quality and the remains of the ancient golden treasure of St. Mark made up of precious goldsmith objects.

Curiosities: The warm colours of the mosaics and particularly the gold one, decorate the ample interior spaces of the Basilica, from 28 metres wide up to 21 metres high, for a total covering of over 8000 square meters.



DID YOU KNOW?

Curiosities about gondola, the typical boat of Venice

The gondola is composed of 280 different pieces and is 11 meters long. It has an asymmetric shape with the left side wider than the right one to be kept it aligned and led by one to four rowers rowing in the Venetian way. That is standing and facing the boat's bow to maneuver the long oar standing on a special support called fórcola. The typical iron in the bow is called "dolfin" instead and useful to weigh down the front part of the boat keeping it on course. Its shape has a precise meaning, it contains the history of the City of Venice and the lagoon.

Squid with black ink

Ingredients for 6 people: 1.3 kg squid; 1 small onion garlic; olive oil; polenta; parsley.

Method: Use 1.3 kg of squid, cleaned and with the insides removed. Put the sac containing the black ink located inside the squid to one side. Cut into 1cm long strips. Fry a small onion and two chopped garlic cloves in a cup of oil. Then add the squid and pour in a cup of dry white wine. Leave to evaporate. Combine the black ink of 4 or 5 sacs, adding a few spoonfuls of warm water. Continue cooking for around 40 minutes. Turn from time to time. When they are ready, season with salt and pepper. Serve with hot, soft polenta and a sprinkling of parsley.

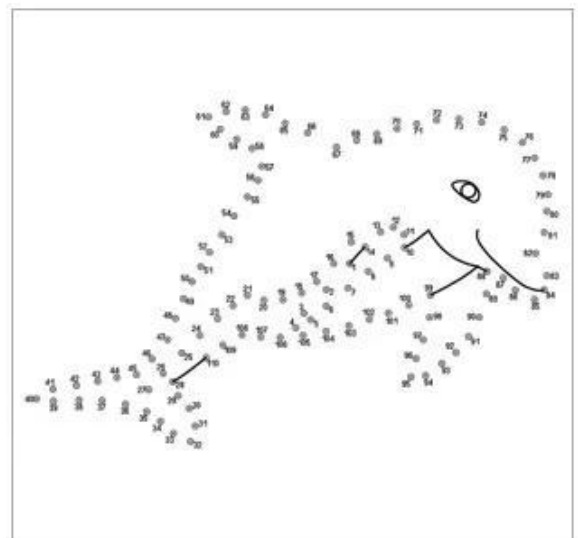

JESOLO AND AROUND

Charm and Art Nouveau atmosphere

The Venice Lido is one of the most well-known islands in the Venetian Lagoon, a fully-fledged watershed between the city and the open sea. With its low and sandy coast, the Lido stretches for about 11 kilometres and attracts tourists with its slow pace and delightful architecture. Seamlessly connected to the centre of Venice by traditional steamboats, the Lido is the only island in the Lagoon that can be explored by road. Most visitors, however, prefer to explore the island by bicycle. This way you can easily move between the Lido and Malamocco, a colourful fishing village, and Alberoni, a port mouth, characterised by high sand dunes, which is nestled in a haven protected by the WWF. For those visiting the Lido, definitely not to be missed are the Abbey of St. Nicholas, which dates back to the 10th century and is the resting place of a part of the remains of the patron saint of sailors, the impressive Liberty architecture of the early 20th century hotels overlooking the Marconi waterfront, and the nearby reserve of Cà Roman, a paradise for birdwatchers.
