Lungomare delle Stelle dedicated to the health service

One of the summer's most eagerly anticipated events returns: the 'Lungomare delle Stelle' ('Promenade of Stars'). Each year, the city dedicates a stretch of its seafront promenade to an important figure. This tradition began back in 2001 with Alberto Sordi, going on to include Andrea Bocelli, Gina Lollobrigida, Katia Ricciarelli, Sophia Loren, Mike Bongiorno and Carla Fracci, and the more recent additions Alessandro Del Piero, Federica Pellegrini, the Italian pop band 'Pooh' and Bebe Vio. This year is unique as it will be dedicated to an entire category of people: healthcare workers, who do so much to look after us and who have fought incredibly hard during the health emergency. The event will be held on Friday 21 August, at 5.30pm, in the square in front of the city hospital (participation is by invitation only, and the event will be broadcast live on the Antenna Tre NordEst channel and on Jesolo's official Facebook page). The world-famous pianist Gloria Campaner will also be performing at the opening ceremony.

The highly-awaited "Poetry at Dawn" fair is back. The 8th edition of this event is organised once again by the Teatro dei Pazzi, in collaboration with the Municipality and the department of Culture. This year's edition will be a reduced version due to the restrictions, but it remains firmly on our calendar. Because summer isn't complete without the beauty of poems read on the seashore at dawn. There will be two readings this summer. Friday 21st August in the beach area of Via Dalmazia, seventh access to the beach in the Marinella kiosk area, with "Sepulveda's words". Friday 28th August, on the beach area of Via Palladio, Palladio kiosk area, with "Tales of the Sea". Both sessions begin at 6:45 am and the actors and musicians are from the Teatro dei Pazzi collective. The event is included on the 2020 RetEventi Cultura regional poster of events.

Sardèe in saor

"Un poche de sardelle vorria mandar a tor, per cusinarle subito, e metterle in saor." In his novel "Le donne de casa soa" Carlo Goldoni talked about this dish, that was traditionally eaten by Venetian families on boats during the Festival of the Redeemer.

400 g sardines; 80 g flour; 40 g pine nuts; 800 g onion; 40 g sultanas; 300 g seed oil; 200 ml white wine vinegar; 80ml white wine.

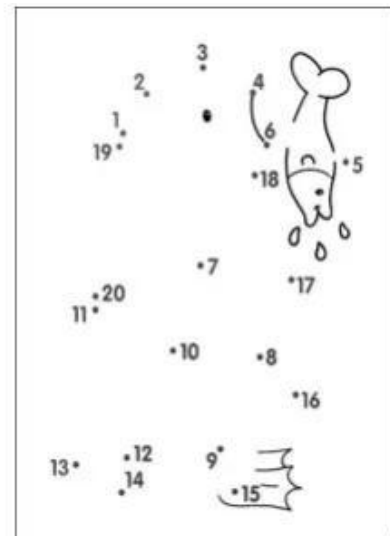
Cook the onion on a low heat for about 40 minutes and wet with vinegar and white wine; add the sultanas and pine nuts. Remove the head and bones of the sardines, coat them in flour and fry in plenty of oil. Arrange layers of sardines alternating with layers of saor. Leave to marinate for at least 24 hours in a cool place.

JESOLO AND AROUND

Chess game

Every second weekend in September of even years, the magnificent Piazza degli Scacchi (chess square) hosts and relives the event of the daughter of Taddeo Parisio, the Lord of Marostica Castle, and the two youths Rinaldo d'Angarano and Vieri da Vallonara who contend for the hand of his beautiful daughter, Lionora. Over 600 people in period costumes reenact the legend of Lionora offering a spectacular performance, enriched by scenic effects and fireworks, knights and dancers, jugglers and fire eaters, comedians and musicians, swordsmen and above all citizens of Marostica. The first show is on Friday 11th and Saturday 12th September at 9 p.m. and it's performed also on Sunday at 5 p.m. and 9. p.m. More info: marosticascacchi.it
