Tropicarium Park

Tropicarium Park Jesolo is a zoological garden which houses over 100 animal species from over 4 continents. The park is divided into 3 parts: The Tropicarium: with turtles, geckos, iguanas, amphibians, super-friendly Magellanic penguins, colourful tropical butterflies and many other interesting animals; Aquarium: with all kinds of colourful and fascinating fresh and salt water fish; Predators: big sharks, crocodiles, alligators and the beautiful biotope aquariums. The visit is a couple of hours long and you can take breaks along the way.

Prices: Family (2 adults + 1 child): € 50.00; Family (2 adults + 2 children): € 60.00; Family + grandparents: grandparents pay like children

Spritz

The legend of the birth of the Spritz dates back to the 1800s during the Habsburg domination. In fact, it appears that the Austrians had taken up the habit of visiting the Venetian winebars; however, the local wine was much more alcoholic than what they were used to. Hence the idea of watering down the wine a bit, to make it lighter, leading to the name "Spritz" (from the German verb "Spritzen", to spray, due to the addition of cold water). Now it's become a trendy aperitif. The basic ingredients of the Spritz are: sparkling water or seltz, Prosecco and according to tradition Aperol or Bitter, but the darker Cynar or China Martinican can also be used. The essential feature of the Spritz is its red colour that comes from the beverage added to the wine.

JESOLO AND AROUND

A wonderful itinerary at the Ghetto of Venice

An itinerary to discover the treasures and the culture of the ancient "Ghetto" of Venice with the possibility to taste Kosher specialties of the Jewish-Venetian cuisine, rich and varied for its cosmopolitan character. The tour begins with a visit to the Banco Rosso, the old pawnshop, closed for centuries and quite recently visited, where is screened an explanatory documentary about life in the ancient ghetto. The visit will continue to the Jewish Museum and into the spiritual and artistic heart of the Ghetto: the five synagogues, known in Venice as "Schole". A guided tasting at the Kosher Restaurant will close the tour. The tour lasts about 3 hours and a half.

The Factory of Science

It is an exhibition, with over one hundred interactive machines, that deals with topics such as the human body, water, mathematics, illusions, electricity, sound and forces. In this context the ludic-experimental approach will be used to educate visitors about scientific knowledge and understand important laws of nature. This is, in short, The Factory of Science. The exhibition is set up in Via Aquileia 123, near Piazza Brescia. The Factory of Science has the ambitious task of promoting scientific culture by allowing students and visitors to get involved with interactive and experimental workstations. They will verify thesis and be surprised by the laws of physics using direct experience.
