Beach Volleyball at JBA

The beach volleyball has a new prestigious sport center in Jesolo: the JBA. Jesolo Beach Arena is located in front of the pinewood area and occupies an area of 5 thousand square meters of beach with 12 sand courts, a wi-fi area, a TV area, numerous relaxation areas and a gym for athletes. A unique space in Italy, that involves every day a lot of enthusiasts. At JBA are organized courses for young people and adults and federal tournaments. The real flagship of the JBA is, however, the biggest youth beach volleyball school in Italy, always focused on the growth of young athletes. For next summer it will also be possible to enrol in the beach volleyball school which, in the last four years, has involved more than eight hundred athletes. Created for children aged 7 to 14, it provides weekly activities strictly on the beach.

Bigoi in salsa (Spaghetti in sardine sauce)

Bigoi in salsa is a typical dish eaten on the eve of big Christian religious celebrations (first Friday of Lent, Christmas Eve, Good Friday and Ash Wednesday).

Recipe

350 g bigoi (durum wheat spaghetti) - 200 g sardines in salt - 500 g white onions - 80 g extra virgin olive oil - salt and pepper (to taste)

Wash and clean the sardines, finely chop the onions. Put the oil into a pan, add the sardines, the onions and the pepper and cook for about 15 minutes. Cook everything until the sardines have dissolved and the onions have wilted. If necessary add a bit of water. Mix the sauce with the spaghetti, which have been cooked in salted water in the meantime "al dente".

JESOLO AND AROUND

Natural oasis of Vallevicchia

Extensive pine forests, lagoons, dunes and cultivated fields make up the natural oasis of Vallevicchia, located between the two popular tourist seaside resorts of Caorle and Bibione, in the province of Venice. For those who have yet to discover Vallevicchia, it is an area of outstanding natural and environmental wealth, one of the largest coastal dune systems in Veneto and last stretch of uninhabited coastline of the upper Adriatic. The island covers about 900 hectares, over half of which are used for experimental and low environmental impact cultivation. Approximately 150 hectares are made up of sandy shores, lowland forest, coastal pine forest and newly formed wetlands. At Vallevicchia it is still possible to observe the flora and fauna typical to sandy coastlines, and it is a reference point for bird watching enthusiasts and for all of those seeking a different type of holiday than that offered by the nearby seaside resorts. The island is simply amazing, a piece of paradise that the EU has recognized as a Special Protection Area and Site of Community Importance.

Recommended period: Spring, Summer, Autumn. More info: www.veneto.eu
