DID YOU KNOW?

Cardio-protected Jesolo City Project

Jesolo City is "cardio-protected" thanks to a network of 100 automatic external defibrillators. This project was activated a few years ago and it has recently been updated and digitised thanks to an interactive map located at the Town Hall, which allows you to identify all the AEDs in the city through your smartphone. It is an interactive digital map which can be viewed on computers, smartphones and tablets to locate the 100 outdoor automatic defibrillators installed around the city. Venetian Style Liver

An ancient recipe of Venetian tradition. The original recipe uses vinegar for practical reasons since there were no fridges in the past and vinegar covered the strong smell that liver developed after a few days.

500 g veal liver - 500 g onion - 120 g seed oil - vinegar to taste - 50 g flour - salt and pepper

Slice the liver finely and brown it in a fryingpan with a little oil, then add a dash of fine vinegar. Slice the liver finely, coat it in flour and cook on a high heat for a few minutes. Add the onion, season with salt and pepper and if needed add a little water then finish cooking. Serve the dish with hot, white polenta.

Peggy Guggenheim. The last dogaressa

The Peggy Guggenheim Collection celebrates the Venetian life of its founder, covering all the exhibitions and events that characterised her thirty years spent on the lagoon, from 1948 to 1979, which have proven to be genuine milestones in the history of 20th century art. The exhibition focuses on the patron's collecting after 1948, after she left New York, closed the Art of This Century gallery-museum and moved to Venice. Around sixty works are on display, including paintings, sculptures and works on paper, selected among those purchased during the forties and 1979, the year she died, by well known and not so well known artists in her collection.

It is an exhibition, with over one hundred interactive machines, that deals with topics such as the human body, water, mathematics, illusions, electricity, sound and forces. In this context the ludic-experimental approach will be used to educate visitors about scientific knowledge and understand important laws of nature. This is, in short, The Factory of Science. The exhibition is set up in Via Aquileia 123, near Piazza Brescia. The Factory of Science has the ambitious task of promoting scientific culture by allowing students and visitors to get involved with interactive and experimental workstations. They will verify thesis and be surprised by the laws of physics using direct experience.
