Tropicarium Park

Tropicarium Park Jesolo is a zoological garden which houses over 100 animal species from over 4 continents. The park is divided into 3 parts: The Tropicarium: with turtles, geckos, iguanas, amphibians, super-friendly Magellanic penguins, colourful tropical butterflies and many other interesting animals; Aquarium: with all kinds of colourful and fascinating fresh and salt water fish; Predators: big sharks, crocodiles, alligators and the beautiful biotope aquariums. The visit is a couple of hours long and you can take breaks along the way.

Prices: Family (2 adults + 1 child): € 50.00; Family (2 adults + 2 children): € 60.00; Family + grandparents: grandparents pay like children

Adults: € 20; Children € 15; Reduced (disabled/military/over65): € 16; Free: children up to 3 years of age and carers of people with disabilities who are not self-sufficient. Opening times: Open every day continuously from 10 am to 10 pm (9 pm last entry time)

DID YOU KNOW?

Where does the name Jesolo come from?

Jesolo was already inhabited in Roman times and had the name of Equilium. The name varied from Equilio, Exulo, Iesolo, Giesolo and Jexollo, until the mid-16th century when it took the name of Cavazuccherina, due to the excavation of the old Zuccherina Quarry. The village became a municipality on 22nd December 1807 when Napoleon I, King of Italy, established it. On the 18th August 1930 the village took the name of Jesolo, thanks to a decree by King Victor Emanuel. In 1984, Jesolo became a "City", with a decree by Sandro Pertini, the then President of the Republic. There are two places where you can get a real feel for Jesolo's roots: at the Kursaal Center, with the mosaic exhibition, and in the archaeological site in Jesolo Paese.

JESOLAN FLAVORS



Tiramisù

Dish made in the aftermath of the Second World War whose name (pick me up) refers to the calorie content.

600 g mascarpone - 300 g sugar - 6 egg yolks - ladyfingers - cold unsweetened coffee - unsweetened cocoa (to taste)

Beat the egg yolks well. Mix the mascarpone and sugar and add the mixture to the egg yolks to obtain a thick, smooth mixture. Soak the ladyfingers in the coffee and arrange them in a dish (oven dish/glass) and cover them with the cream. Continue arranging alternating layers until the cream is finished. On the last layer, which should be the cream, dust with cocoa and refrigerate for a couple of hours.

JESOLO AND AROUND

Sant'Erasmo

The island of Sant'Erasmo can be considered a haven of peace and tranquillity, far from the chaotic tourist trails of nearby Venice. Its distinctly agricultural character has ancient roots: the fruits and vegetables used to supply the city were cultivated right here since the Middle Ages on a strip of land reclaimed from the waters, between Punta Sabbioni. The tranquillity and solitude of this place allowed the few farmers living here to nurture vegetable gardens and vineyards interspersed by ghebi, shallow furrows which sketched an orderly weave across the land. The sleepy, rural rhythm of life on the island contrasted with the traffic and chaos of commercial Venice, making the island of Sant'Erasmo a countryside haven of peace. Today Sant'Erasmo is linked to the mainland by a ferry that connects it with Cavallino Treporti. Visitors continue to appreciate the serenity that reigns on the island, which retains its agricultural tradition celebrated every year in two major events: the May festival of the famous purple artichoke (a Slow Food Product) and the October festival dedicated to must. The island is about four kilometres long and is ideal for a bike ride or going for a walk. More info: www.veneto.eu
