A Blue Flag, for the quality of the sea. And a Green Flag, for being a special destination for children and youngsters. Sardèe in saor

"Un poche de sardelle vorria mandar a tor, per cusinarle subito, e metterle in saor." In his novel "Le donne de casa soa" Carlo Goldoni talked about this dish, that was traditionally eaten by Venetian families on boats during the Festival of the Redeemer.

400 g sardines; 80 g flour; 40 g pine nuts; 800 g onion; 40 g sultanas; 300 g seed oil; 200 ml white wine vinegar; 80ml white wine.

Cook the onion on a low heat for about 40 minutes and wet with vinegar and white wine; add the sultanas and pine nuts. Remove the head and bones of the sardines, coat them in flour and fry in plenty of oil. Arrange layers of sardines alternating with layers of saor. Leave to marinate for at least 24 hours in a cool place.

JESOLO AND AROUND

Sacred Sites of Venice

The magic and charm of Venice is a precious treasure made of elegant palaces, magnificent works of art and, above all, impressive churches. The majestic Basilica of San Marco is a monument made unique by its long history, stunning facade and precious mosaics that narrate episodes from the Old and New Testament. The Basilica of Santa Maria della Salute is a place of great religious importance; it was built in gratitude to the Virgin Mary for deliverance from the plague in 1630. Other important places of worship and art are the Church of San Rocco, the Basilica of Santa Maria dei Frari, and, on the Giudecca Island, the Church of the Redeemer (il Redentore), which was built to a design by Palladio and is the heart of the festival that is celebrated here every year in the summer.
