The lagoon, with its northern appendix, worms its way into the Jesolo area between the river and the agricultural land. Jesolo, the new city logo makes you bigger

It appears gigantic and coloured at night. It's the large format word "Jesolo" installed at the foot of the two towers distinguishing the city skyline, in Piazza Drago. It's a welcome message to many tourists choosing Jesolo, every year, for their holidays. After the big Ferris Wheel, therefore, another symbol that recalls the world capitals like Toronto, for example. Dimensions and characteristics of the "3D" sign are very important measuring almost 14 meters in width and 3 in height, and it is equipped with RGB LED lighting system. The same inscription then shows the typeface chosen by the Municipality for some years for the new city logo, with the aim of having an identifying "brand" for city promotion.

Spritz

The legend of the birth of the Spritz dates back to the 1800s during the Habsburg domination. In fact, it appears that the Austrians had taken up the habit of visiting the Venetian winebars; however, the local wine was much more alcoholic than what they were used to. Hence the idea of watering down the wine a bit, to make it lighter, leading to the name "Spritz" (from the German verb "Spritzen", to spray, due to the addition of cold water). Now it's become a trendy aperitif. The basic ingredients of the Spritz are: sparkling water or seltz, Prosecco and according to tradition Aperol or Bitter, but the darker Cynar or China Martinican can also be used. The essential feature of the Spritz is its red colour that comes from the beverage added to the wine.

The Factory of Science

It is an exhibition, with over one hundred interactive machines, that deals with topics such as the human body, water, mathematics, illusions, electricity, sound and forces. In this context the ludic-experimental approach will be used to educate visitors about scientific knowledge and understand important laws of nature. This is, in short, The Factory of Science. The exhibition is set up in Via Aquileia 123, near Piazza Brescia. The Factory of Science has the ambitious task of promoting scientific culture by allowing students and visitors to get involved with interactive and experimental workstations. They will verify thesis and be surprised by the laws of physics using direct experience.
