

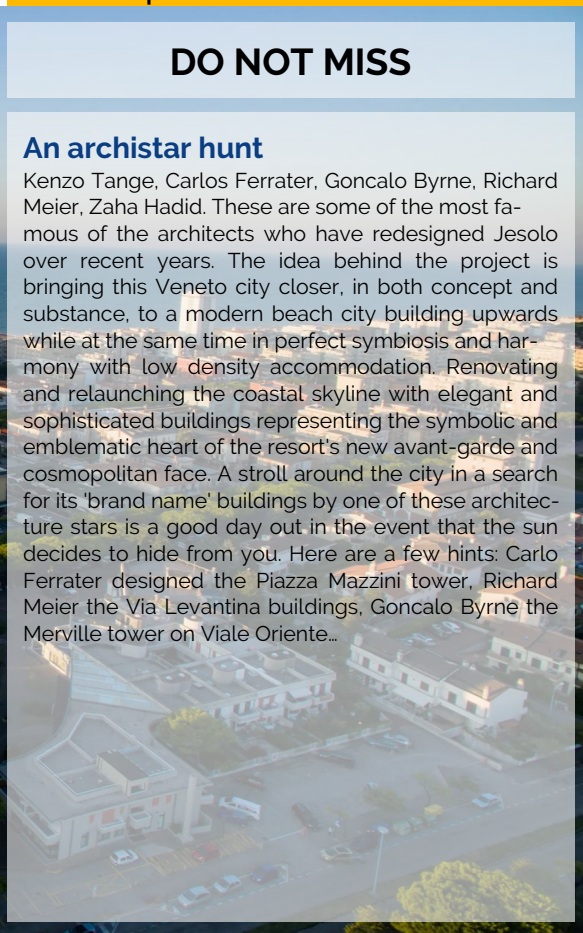

Kenzo Tange, Carlos Ferrater, Goncalo Byrne, Richard Meier, Zaha Hadid. These are some of the most famous of the architects who have redesigned Jesolo over recent years. ### Atvo Express

ATVO offers a comfortable bus service from/to Marco Polo Airport to/from Lido di Jesolo: frequent scheduled trips, plus eight daily express services including already in the price luggage and urban bus from Jesolo bus station to your accommodation and/or viceversa. If you book your tickets online, at the airport you can go directly to the bus departure stop, immediately outside the arrivals hall, show your tickets (optional printing) to ATVO's staff and leave for Jesolo, avoiding driving and parking stress. On the way back the bus will also drop you off directly in front of the passenger terminal. ### Venezia, Murano, Burano e Torcello

You can arrive in Venice and the main islands on the Lagoon, such as Murano, Burano and Torcello, by sea on the Moby Dick II from three docks in Cortellazzo, in piazza Milano and piazza Marconi (right on the beach). It will be an unforgettable, carefree trip amidst nature to discover the world-famous attractions of the Lagoon and, especially, to visit Venice, a city unlike any other in the world for its art and beauty. ## JESOLAN FLAVORS

### Soave Superiore D.O.C.G

Soave Superiore, produced in the hilly area of Soave, obtained the D.O.C.G. designation in 2001. Such a highquality wine is the result of a perfect balance of the area of cultivation, controlled yield in the field and accurate preservation prior to bottling in the winery. Soave Superiore, becoming Soave Superiore classico when it is produced in the area defined as "classica", can only be sold after a refining period of at least three months in the bottle, which safeguards the characteristics of the mature and complex wine. The straw yellow colour of Soave Superiore D.O.C.G. is more intense than the Soave D.O.C., although it keeps the typical brightness of a young wine. It is characterised by a floral, more intense bouquet and a full and subtly bitter taste. The D.O.C.G. designation also includes Soave Superiore riserva and Soave Superiore classico riserva. For the riserva, the refining period requires at least two years, three months of which must be in the bottles. Its colour is also an intense straw yellow, while its flavour is well-rounded, intense and it has a slightly bitter aftertaste. More info: [www.veneto.eu](http://www.veneto.eu)



## JESOLO AND AROUND

### Glass Museum in Murano

The museum is located on the Murano island in the patrician's palace of Giustinian, which was originally the residence of the bishops of Torcello. The exhibition includes important ancient Roman findings from the 1st to the 3rd century after Christ and the largest historical collection of Murano glass, with the major art pieces that have been produced in the period between 15th and 20th century. Among them some of the world famous glass master pieces of Venini, Zecchin, Carlo Scarpa. The rooms are often enriched by precious temporary collections and in the suggestive garden are presented contemporary glass works. Opening hours: from November 1st till March 31st 10.30 a.m.-4.30 p.m. from April 1st till October 31st 10.30 a.m.-6 p.m. Ticket prices: full ticket €10,00, reduced ticket €7,50. Combined ticket with Lace Museum: full ticket €12,00, reduced ticket €8,00.
