Ready, set....Pista Azzurra!

Thrills, the roar of engines, and adrenaline running through your veins. This is Pista Azzurra, one of the most important circuits in the world, a true icon of the international go-kart panorama. Over the course of years, the best world-class go-kart pilots, many of whom went on to Formula 1, after having competed on this track. Senna, Patrese, Prost, Zanardi, Fisichella, Hamilton, Schumacher... just to name a few. And if you want to try out the thrill of go-karting for yourself, Pista Azzurra has a rental service. There are two tracks, one for test pilots ages 16 and up, and one for children. The rental karts have a 4-stroke Honda engine.

Ombra de vin

Since the 19th century, the travelling wine salesmen who sold their wine in St. Mark's Square, to keep the product cool and protected from the heat that sometimes suffocated the whole of Venice, used to move their stalls around St. Mark's bell tower, following the *ombra* (shade) it provided as the sun moved. In 1889 the "alla Speranza" restaurant in San Polo began to officially use the name *ombra* for a standard glass of wine. Still today in the "bacari", the traditional Venetian wine bars you can hear people ordering an *ombra*. An *ombra* is traditionally served with "cicheti", delicious tastes of Venetian recipes: polenta with salt cod, fish or meat balls, baby octopus, *sarde in saor*, baby cuttlefish, fried courgette flowers, etc.

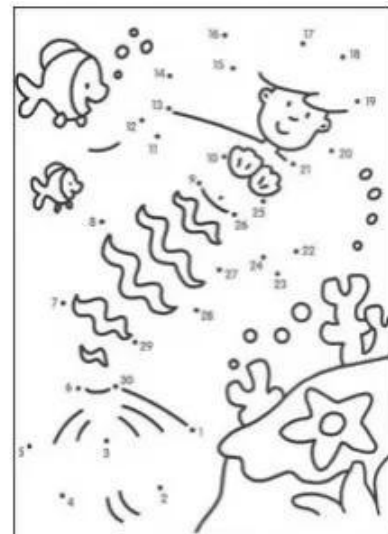

Torre del'Orologio

A fascinating journey inside this ancient 16th century tower, called the Moors Tower, allows a discovery of the mechanisms of pulleys, weights and counterweights in the ancient clock, as well as an exceptional view from the upper terrace, of St. Mark's Square below it. Visit only upon prior booking, with specialized guide, from Monday to Wednesday at 10am and 11am and from Thursday to Sunday at 2pm and 3pm.
